

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

OF

I, _____, a resident of _____, _____
County, Texas declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, and hereby expressly
revoke all prior Wills and codicils.

ARTICLE I

I direct that all of my legal debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon as
practicable after my death.

ARTICLE II

I direct that my INDEPENDENT EXECUTRIX pay out of my residuary estate,
without apportionment, all estate, inheritance succession and other taxes, assessed
by reason of my death by the government of the United States or by the State of
Texas if any shall then be owing.

ARTICLE III

I appoint my wife, _____, as my INDEPENDENT
EXECUTRIX of this Will. If she is unable or unwilling to act or continue to act in that
capacity, then I appoint _____, as my INDEPENDENT
EXECUTOR of this Will. I direct that no action shall be taken in any court in the
administration of my estate other than probating and recording of this Will and the
return of an inventory appraisalment and list of claims of my estate. No bond or other
security shall be required of any EXECUTOR appointed in this Will.

ARTICLE IV

If any person whether or not related in any way by blood to me shall either
directly or indirectly attempt to oppose or set aside the probate of this Will or to
impair or invalidate any of the provisions hereof and such person shall establish a
right to any part of my estate, I give and bequeath to such person the sum of ONE
DOLLAR (\$1.00) only and no further interest whatsoever in my estate.

ARTICLE V

I bequeath to my wife, _____, all the rest and residue
of my estate, being all of my property, both real and personal, owned by me at the
time of my death. If my wife shall not survive me by five (5) days, then I bequeath

all of my property in trust to _____, for the use and benefit of my minor children _____.

ARTICLE VI

It is hereby expressed as my desire that should my wife _____ predecease me or not survive me by thirty (30) days that _____, be hereby irrevocably appointed Guardian for my minor children _____.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I hereby declare this to be my Last Will and Testament and herewith sign my name to same (typewritten on 5 pages, including the attestation clause, signature of witnesses and my self-proving acknowledgment and the affidavits of the witnesses), in the presence of the undersigned attesting witnesses, all present at the same time, each of whom signed this Will at my request, in my presence and in the presence of each other, all done this _____ day of _____, 20____.

The undersigned each of whom is over fourteen (14) years of age, hereby declare that the Testator declared to us that the foregoing instrument is his Last Will and Testament and that he requested us to act as witnesses to the same and to his signature thereon. He thereupon signed said Will in our presence, all of us being present at the same time. And we now, at his request and in his presence and in the presence of each other, do hereunto sign our names as attesting witnesses, on this _____ day of _____, 20____ at _____
_____, _____ County, Texas. We, and each of us, declare that we believe the said Testator to be of sound mind and memory.
